NOMINATION CRITERIA

A nominee must be or have been involved with arts and culture, with contributions and/or work having a significant impact in Contra Costa County and beyond. Individuals nominated in previous years who were not selected may be nominated again.

There are no award categories. An individual, business or organization may be nominated for work or contributions in any discipline or combinations of efforts. Examples include Performing Arts, Visual Arts, Literary Arts, Digital Arts, Arts Administration, Arts Education, Volunteer Support, Art/Cultural Philanthropy, etc.

Nominees can include individuals from non-profit or for-profit organizations who show exceptional leadership, vision and commitment to the growth and support of arts and culture; organizations or individuals who show continuous and/or significant financial or in-kind support to arts/culture-related organizations; or individuals that help keep Contra Costa arts and/or culture alive.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION GUIDELINES

You may submit:

- Up to four (4) supporting documents (brochures, photos, news articles, etc.) that depict a nominee's work and symbolizes the positive influence the nominee has had in fostering arts and/or culture in Contra Costa County.
- Evidence of the nominee's leadership, vision, and commitment in advancing the arts and/or culture in Contra Costa County.
- Description of a nominee's development of any groundbreaking project(s) within the arts and/or cultural development.
- Please note: The size of all emailed attachments combined must be less that 8 MB or sent as a compressed .zip file.
