The East Bay Regional Park District and the National Park Service proudly announce future plans to provide a new regional park and visitor center in Concord on the former Concord Naval Weapons Station. Concord Hills Regional Park is the working name for a world class regional park that will provide a full range of trail opportunities, wildlife preservation, and environmental and historic interpretation.

On Saturday, July 13, the public will have an opportunity to witness the signing of the conveyance, by the US Navy to the Park District and National Park Service, of 2,216 acres of the former naval property. In the morning, join the Friends of Port Chicago and the National Park Service to learn more about the history of Port Chicago and how the site became a National Memorial. After the speaker presentations and lunch, there will be ongoing tours of the future visitor center, and walking and driving tours to preview the new parkland.

Driving Directions

From CA-4 take exit 20A for Bailey Road South. Head south on Bailey Road. Continue for approximately 1.4 miles (if you arrive at Myrtle Drive you've gone too far) and turn right on the unnamed road. Go past opened gates, and continue approximately 1.8 miles on the unnamed road, turn right to enter the parking lot.

From Downtown Concord take Parkside Drive south. Turn left on Concord Boulevard. Turn left on Bailey Road. Continue for approximately .9 miles (if you arrive at Willow Avenue you've gone too far) and turn left on the unnamed Road. Go past opened gates, and continue approximately 1.8 miles on the unnamed road, turn right to enter the parking lot.

Event signs will be posted at the former gate entrance and parking lot.
